Position Announcement: Boys Soccer Coach

Located on a beautiful campus in Cornwall-on-Hudson, New York, surrounded by 4,000 acres of forest and an hour from New York City, Storm King offers a diverse, inclusive community grounded in character, balance, trust, and academic excellence.

We are seeking a Boys Soccer Coach. The soccer coach will be responsible for the development of student-athletes' skills in soccer, as well as development in areas with alignment to SKS school values: Truth, Respect, and Responsibility. Coaching experience is required, playing experience is preferred. The soccer coach may be asked to participate in regular staff meetings in alignment with their position in athletics. Candidates must have a valid driver's license and pass all applicable background checks.

This position is seasonal, starting September 3rd and extending through November 13th. Practices are from 3:30 - 5:15 PM. Games will be on Wednesdays, Fridays or Saturdays. Travel game distances range up to two hours from campus.
